ALL-STAR REPORT



"I was honored to be asked to coach the CEVA 15U Boys All-Star team at a prestigious four-day tournament at this year's All-Stars, a true milestone for our athletes and our region. Tryouts were held in May, and a team of 10 athletes were elected by 5 coaches. We held a mini camp just before we left for Madison where the athletes had a chance to scrimmage against older athletes on day 1 and then against athletes in their age range on day 2.

This event provided an incredible opportunity for these young players to showcase their talent on a big stage, competing under FIVB rules. These included playing best three out of five sets, a men's net height, six substitutions, and mandatory technical timeouts at 13 points. For many of these players, it was a brand-new experience, as 60% of the team had never competed in a large-scale venue or played a match of this format before.

Despite the challenges, the athletes rose to the occasion, demonstrating resilience, teamwork, and skill throughout the tournament. Off the court, the experience was equally rewarding. The team bonded through after tournament activities such as water volleyball, nightly team dinners, miniature golf and connecting with the CEVA All-Stars Girls team - creating memories that will last a lifetime and strengthening the sense of community within our region.

This tournament wasn't just about competition - it was a platform to showcase the depth of volleyball talent emerging from Oregon and Southwest Washington. I'm proud of the way these athletes represented CEVA and look forward to seeing this momentum continue for many years to come. The future of boys' volleyball in our region is bright, and this experience marks an exciting step toward putting CEVA on the national map."
