EVENT CODE OF CONDUCT

USA Volleyball is committed to the **SAFETY** and **WELL-BEING** of every participant and spectator at this event and will not tolerate harassment, discrimination, abuse, or misconduct. By entering this event, you **AGREE** to abide by the following **STANDARDS** of behavior:

I WILL

- I will*** always display good sportsmanship.
- I will*** educate myself on the unique rules of this facility and abide by them.
- I will*** be polite and respectful to everyone.
- I will*** immediately notify the event director if I witness any harassment or discrimination.
- I will*** acknowledge that the spectator seating around the courts is for the primary use of those watching the match in progress.
- I will*** acknowledge that spectators may rightfully choose to remain in a seat for an entire match without switching sides of the court if/when teams switch.

I WILL NOT

- I will not*** exhibit any behavior that is unruly, disruptive, threatening, or violent in nature, including verbal or physical harassment toward anyone.
- I will not*** display signs, symbols or images, or use language or make gestures that are threatening, abusive or discriminatory toward an individual's race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, disability, gender, gender identity, and/or sexual orientation.
- I will not*** bring and/or carry any weapons including, but not limited to, knives, concealed weapons, and firearms into the event.
- I will not*** use tobacco, vaping devices or e-cigarettes, marijuana, illegal drugs, or controlled substances at this event.
- I will not*** bring on site or consume alcohol while inside the venue of any youth/junior volleyball event.

Failure to abide by the above code of conduct may result in immediate sanction and/or removal from this event.

WARNING:

There is risk of injury from volleyballs or other objects at this event. Attend at your own risk. Please pay close attention to your surroundings and be on alert at all times, especially during active play.

NOTICES

Tournament and facility staff have the right to request spectators be moved if their seating limits a playing area, blocks an exit, or otherwise disrupts the event. Unruly or disrespectful fans, coaches, or players will be asked to leave the tournament. Coaches and clubs are responsible for the behavior of their members. The CEVA Regional Championship is a private event owned and operated by CEVA, under the rules and regulations required for sanctioning by USA Volleyball.

Admission to this event is a revocable privilege.

Official media representatives must be designated with media credentials, representing their own individual publications or news sources. Any other person or entity conducting business in any CEVA competition venue, including Portland Expo Center, without authorization are subject to removal from the premises.

Distribution of flyers is strictly prohibited at all CEVA events. Violators will be prosecuted. This includes the papering of vehicles in the parking lot.

Official CEVA photographers, designated with a CEVA credential, as well as the tournament and facility staff, have the right to ask spectators to relocate any video or photography equipment, including tripods, if they are deemed a safety hazard, are infringing on walkways or aisles, or if they impede CEVA staff or vendors in the execution of their official duties.




All commercial activities must have prior written authorization of the CEVA staff.

Parking:

Paid parking is available via a link on the CEVA website (www.cevaregion.org/regionals) starting 4/20. Participant drop-off areas are available on the South & North curbs of the parking lot. Tri-Met also has a stop at the Expo Center.

Admissions Fees:

General Admission (6 & Over) - \$10.00 per day / \$18.00 weekend pass

Courts:

24 total courts – numbers 1-14 are in Hall E, numbers 15-24 are in Hall D.

Entrance:

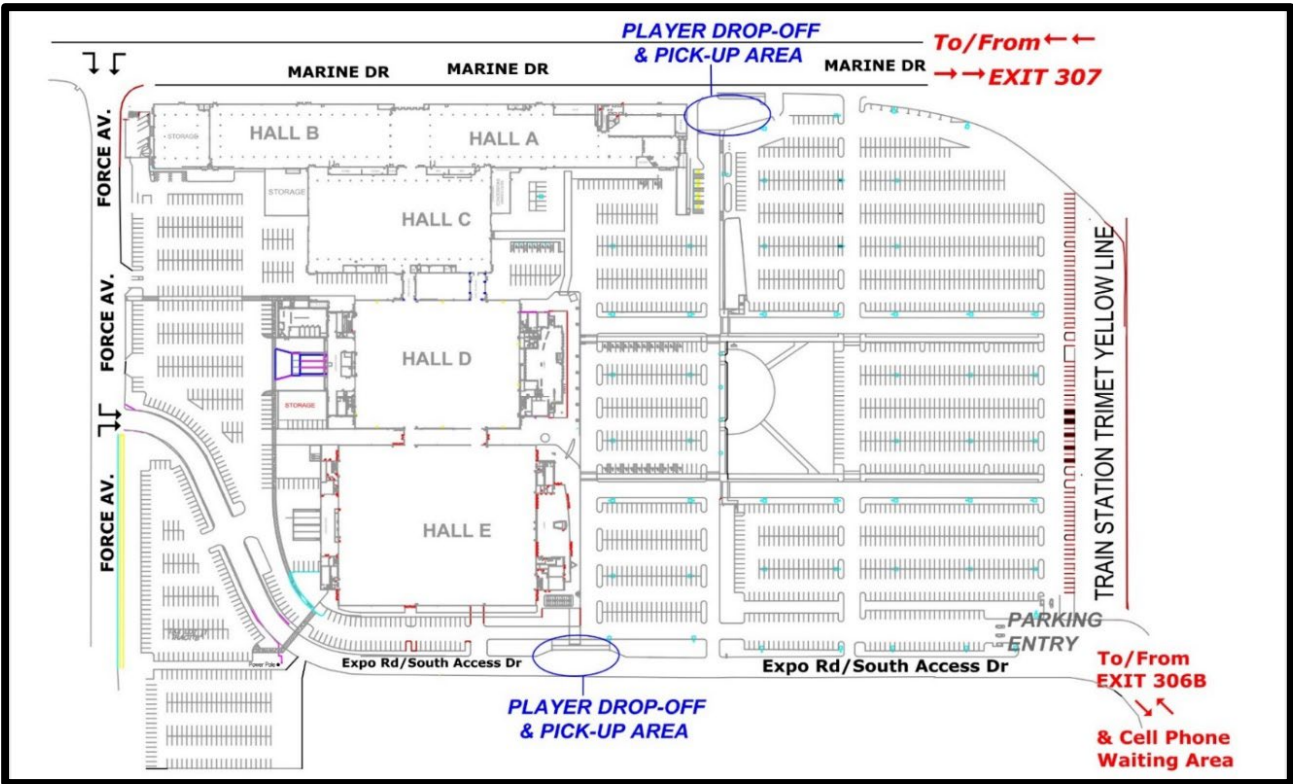
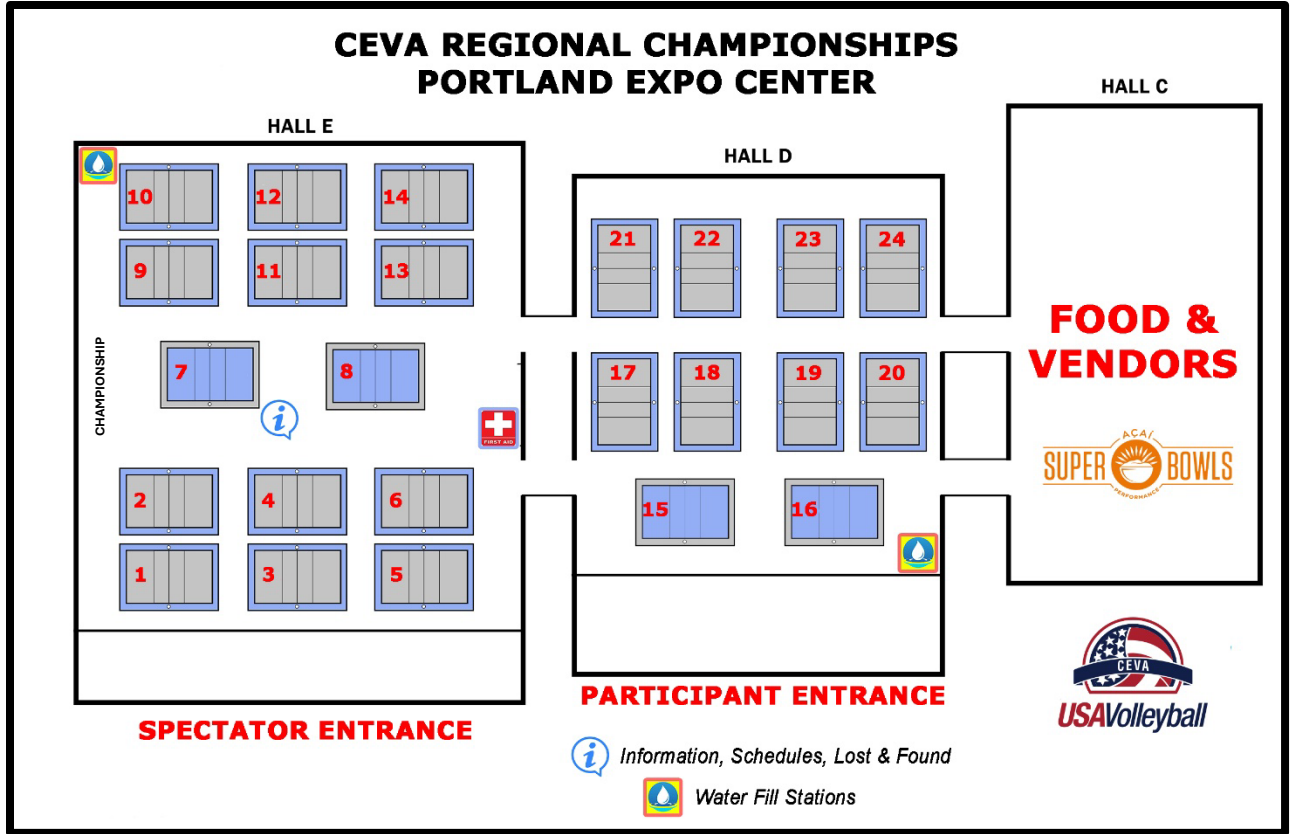
Spectators may enter through the main doors of Hall E – the southern-most building on the Expo campus. Participants may enter through the main doors of Hall D.

Facility Policies:

- **No outside food, drinks, or coolers may be brought in the facility.**
- **No ball handling anywhere except on a court.**
- **No warming up (e.g., running, ball handling) anywhere except on a court.**
- **No large bags or outside chairs may be brought in the facility.**
- Hang-out areas are in Hall C. No camping in Halls E or D. Players' bags must stay with the team.
- No balloons, glitter, or pom-poms allowed in the facility.
- No smoking or tobacco products may be brought to the Expo campus.
- No animals or pets, except ADA service animals, are allowed in the facility.
- No overnight parking, tailgating, or tent setup in the parking lot
- No alcohol is permitted at the event, except in licensed and designated areas where it may be legally dispensed and consumed. Any alcohol purchased must stay in these areas. No outside alcohol is permitted on the PEC campus. Violators are subject to ejection from the PEC campus.
- Facility and CEVA are not responsible for lost/stolen items.

Parking:

- See the map below for designated parking areas.
- Contact olympus@athenavb.net with any questions about parking.
- Each team will receive two parking permits for their coaches.
- Reserved parking is available for purchase on the day of the tournament. Free parking is located on the 2nd and 3rd levels of the First Tech Federal Credit Union parking structure across the street. No trailers or RVs in the Olympus Sports Center lot.
- Please stay in designated tournament spots at the facility.
- Overnight parking is not permitted.

Admissions Fees (Cashless Facility)

- Adults - \$10.00
- Kids & Seniors (60+) - \$6.00
- Kids Under 12 – Free (accompanied by parents/guardians)

Courts:

6 total courts

Entrance:

Participants & spectators may enter through the main entrance off the parking lot.

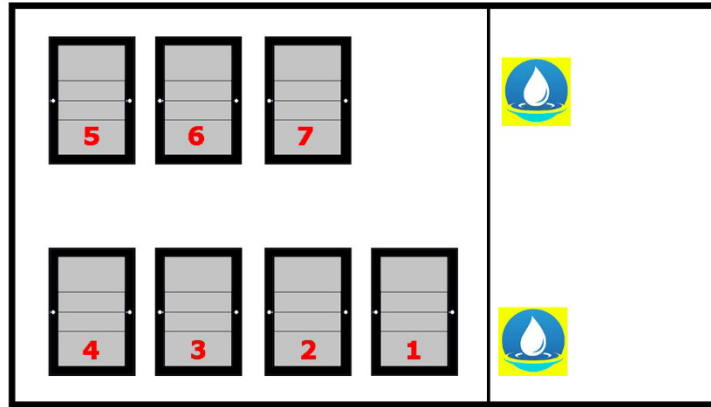
Facility Policies:

- Teams may rent team spaces in the upstairs of the facility – please visit <https://www.sideline.social> to rent your team space. These rented spaces are the only area outside food is allowed and are intended for use by the athletes, coaches and team chaperone. Spaces range from \$65-\$85 per day.
- No outside food is allowed anywhere else in the facility.
- Any drinks on the courts MUST be in a sealed container that you can hold upside down without spilling and must be in-hand. ONLY water is allowed on the courts. Drinks found unattended will be discarded.
- Outside chairs are NOT allowed. Bleacher Seat Cushions are acceptable. Bleachers and chairs are available. No outside tables, BBQs, or appliances allowed. No propane tanks allowed in the parking lot. No glass containers permitted.
- No tents are permitted in the parking lots.
- Shaken Knot Stirred Cafe is now open. No outside food is allowed in the café. Items purchased in the cafe must be consumed in the cafe area. Athletes that purchase from the café may bring food to their cooler table space if team has rented a space.
- The facility is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

INSTRUCTIONS

Free priority parking available for coaches, officials, and tournament staff.

Paid reserved parking available for participants in front of the facility.

Free parking available for participants at the First Tech parking structure (Levels 2 & 3 only).

Do NOT cross Brookwood Pkwy directly as it is unsafe due to fast moving traffic. Use the walking path with tunnel access under Brookwood. It is a quick walk.

Vehicles may be towed at owners expense if parked in unauthorized locations.

Player Dropoff Instructions
Drop off will be on the building side of the coaches parking area. Please follow the cones to the end to do a U turn.

When exiting the parking lot please turn right.





PARKING

Please note the following general policies regarding parking at both the Expo Center and Olympus Sports Center:

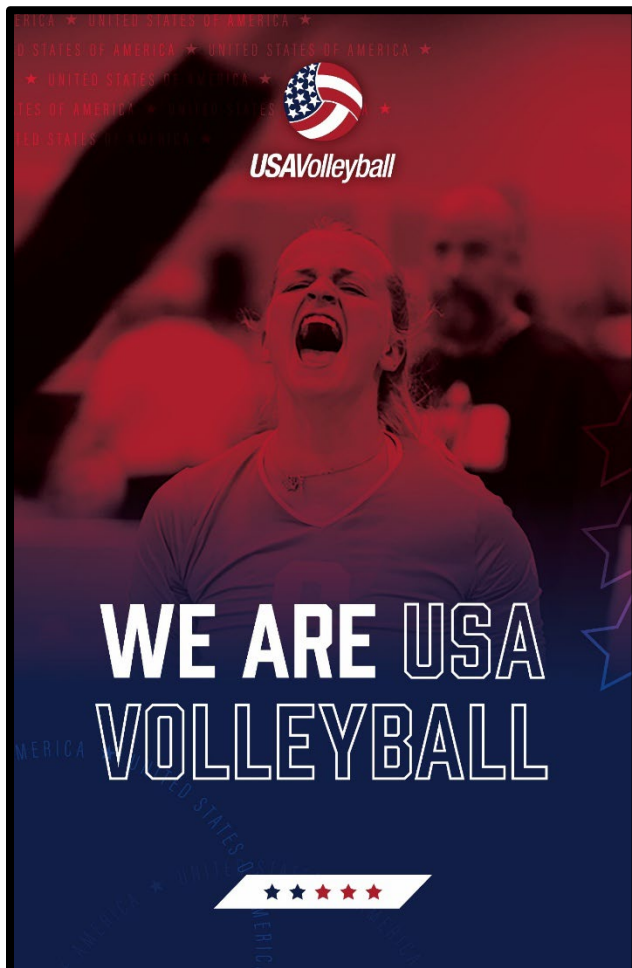
- Vehicles must be always parked legally. Vehicles parked illegally are subject to tow at the owner's expense.
- Both Expo & Olympus have drop-off locations that allow participants to be dropped off without a parking purchase.
- Teams **may switch facilities** between Saturday and Sunday. Parking fees are non-refundable, so please confirm what facility your team is playing at before purchasing a parking permit.
- Permits purchased at Expo are not valid at Olympus, and vice versa.
- Permits purchased for Week 1 and not valid for Week 2 (and vice versa).
- "Tailgate" setups are not permitted in the parking lots at either facility.

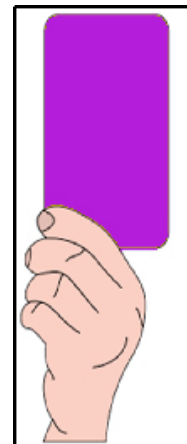
TOURNAMENT LOGISTICS

- Scores and schedules are posted in AES. **Scan the QR Code for updated information!**
- All matches are best of 3. There is never a point cap. Teams will not switch sides.
- Coaches are required to turn in a roster to the official on their court prior to their first match on Saturday. Rosters don't need to be turned in on Sunday.
- Rostered adults must serve as the R2 for all matches in this event.
- Prior to a team's first match of the day, warm-up times are 5-4-4. In all other rounds, warm-up times are 2-4-4.



PURPLE CARD POLICY

CEVA's Purple Card Policy is in effect at this tournament. The role of a spectator at this event is to watch matches, support participants in a positive way, and be respectful toward everybody else. Don't worry about the score, the officiating, and **JUST BE NICE TO EACH OTHER.**





EXPO CENTER SITE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

In 1942, President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed an Executive Order that authorized the Secretary of War to declare certain areas of the country “military zones,” where certain individuals or groups could be legally excluded. This order significantly impacted Japanese Americans living on the West Coast at the time.

Following the attack on Pearl Harbor, there was a great fear among American citizens and the American Government that further attacks by Japanese citizens were imminent.

Japanese American citizens were detained and sent to internment camps in various parts of Oregon, while they waited for relocation to more permanent areas in different states. One of those internment camps was located on what is now the Portland Expo Center campus.

CEVA recognizes the injustice behind those detainments, and will continue to support a safe, inclusive, and welcoming environment for everybody. We feel this era in our history is important to understand so those same mistakes are not repeated.

Take a moment to visit *Voices of Remembrance* – a memorial at the PEC Expo Center MAX Station. The memorial honors those who were incarcerated at the site, which was then called Portland Assembly Center.

We encourage our members to educate themselves about this period in our state’s history and our country’s history.
